

Court Costs In Partridge Case Reach \$420.32

Costs for prosecuting Philip H. Partridge on charges of burning and burglary of a school amounted to a total of \$420.32, Harold D. Mason, county clerk of courts, reported Wednesday.

Mason said that \$251.75 was the costs of jurors' fees, and the remainder of the total was taken up by clerk fees, sheriff fees, and other costs.

Of the total, the defendant will be required to pay \$310.37, the clerk said. The difference in the amount to be paid by him and the total cost of prosecution is the money paid to jurors who reported for duty but were not called to serve.
