

NAACP Fails to File Appeal in U. S. Court

Court attaches at the U. S. District Court in Cincinnati said Saturday that no additional entries had been filed in the Hillsboro school case although officials of the NAACP had indicated that a notice of appeal would be filed in the recent ruling of the district judge in the local dispute.

Court workers did report, however, that Judge John H. Druffel had signed a journal entry, confirming his previous decision made in the courtroom. His ruling at that time was that he would delay decision in the current case until after the Supreme Court has outlined desegregation rules.
